

Wubs start Chesterville shuttle

WINCHESTER — There are now three bus routes local commuters can use to travel to Ottawa.

The Wubs family of Winchester, who operates Wubs Transportation, has two commuter shuttle services up and running.

The first bus route, which Wubs took over from fellow transportation company Laidlaw International, continues to leave from Winchester in the mornings. A second bus starts its morning route in Chesterville and leaves at 6:15 am from the Chesterville Arena.

South Mountain Stagecoach Transit will start their own motor coach service on Tues., March 31. The route makes its first stop at Inkerman at 6:15 am before taking a more

north-west route into the city.

With three buses taking commuters into Ottawa, local residents now have another way to get into the city.

“There’s a lot of benefit to having this transit system out here,” said Nanda Wubs.

Wubs noted that several local factories have closed their doors, and residents can use the rural bus systems to commute to work in Ottawa.

“We heard from people that they’re desperate for service,” said Wubs.

Both South Mountain Stagecoach Transit and Wubs Transportation hook up directly to the City of Ottawa’s OC Tranpo system.
